### Are We Just Learning to be Nice?

The culture around and within our churches constantly shifts and changes. The events and spaces the church used to "own" now face competition for time and attention. Most congregations are willing to try about anything to get families and kids in the door. But do we know what we want once we get them there? Parents used to send their children to church for "moral values and community service", but even that development is increasingly available in other places through things like character education and volunteer hour requirements. How do we reclaim a space in the lives of children, youth, and the families that form them? Perhaps we need to ask first, "what space is it that we are trying to claim?"

**Bryce Wiebe** serves as the Director of Special Offerings for the Presbyterian Church (USA). In this work, he seeks to connect Presbyterians to the impact of our shared mission and inspire their participation. Prior to this, he worked with the Presbyterian Hunger Program and as a Christian Educator.

Bryce holds an MDiv from Yale Divinity School and BA degrees in Music and Business Administration from Hastings College and retains part-ownership of a small, sourdough bread bakery in Nebraska.
